Our attendees had much to say about the Day of Reflection. Read on for more.




Fr. Paul Deutsch gave a perfect Day of Reflection at White House in St. Louis.





Do You Have a Charitable Gift Annuity with the Province?

There are about 75 donors who receive regular annuity checks from the **Jesuits USA Central and Southern Province** because of a charitable gift annuity they committed to in years past.

If you would like to get a monthly or quarterly check from the province, it's easy enough to do. Call **Paula Parrish, Chief Advancement Officer**, and she can walk you through it. The minimum criteria are age 80 years old or older and an initial gift of \$50,000. Be sure to check with your financial advisor or family attorney before engaging in any planned gift.

Celebrating 50 years as a Jesuit in 2024, **Fr. Patrick Quinn, SJ**, is a pastor at heart.


"There has always been something special to me about parishes. It is in parishes that I really came to see the presence of what Pope Francis calls 'ordinary saints,'" he said.

Father Quinn has come to value service as the core of his Jesuit vocation, though it began in a setting far from parishes: university campus computer systems.

"There's really a grace that's received from the families when they share what's going on in their lives," he said. "People feel like they're known, that they belong, that they're welcomed, that they're part of something bigger."

Andy and Pat Shannon



For decades, Andy and Pat Shannon have donated their time, talent and treasure to advancing the mission of the Society of Jesus.

The Shannons began making retreats as a married couple at Montserrat Jesuit Retreat House in Lake Dallas, Texas, in 1969. The fruits of those encounters with God and the Jesuits have encouraged them to work with and support the Jesuits financially. They developed strong friendships with several Jesuits.

The Shannons remain invested in Jesuit education decades after their own children attended. The Shannon Family Scholarship – A Man for Others, which awards tuition assistance to a junior at Jesuit Dallas each year – is one way they

continue to make an impact.

In addition, inspired by the impact the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius have had on their lives, they donate to Jesuit formation and Montserrat Jesuit Retreat House.

"The fruits of the Jesuits' work motivate us," said Andy.
